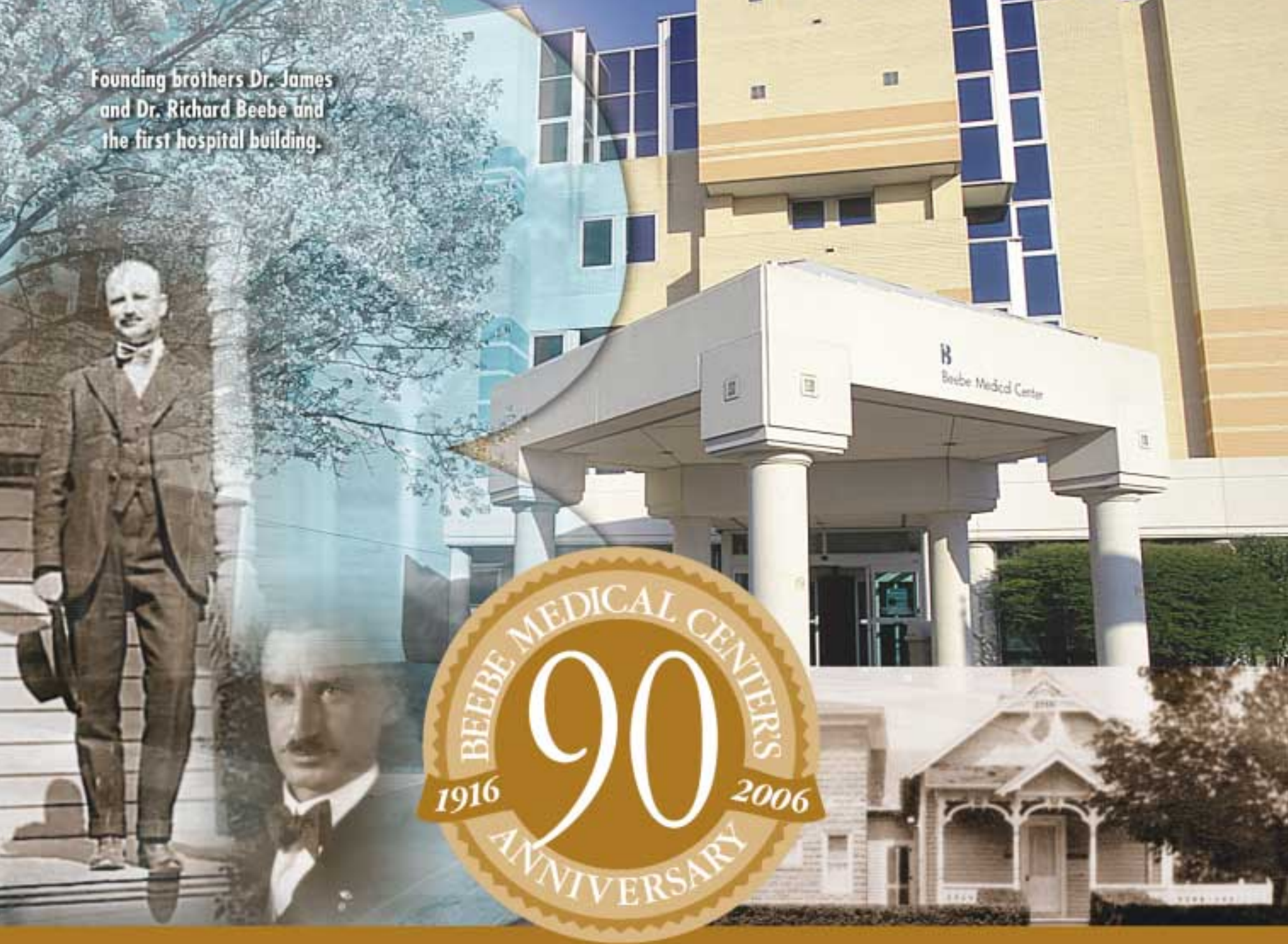

BEEBE MEDICAL CENTER'S HEALTHCARE EXTENDS BEYOND ITS WALLS

It was the beginning of the 20th century,

when electric lights and a water-and-sewer system were under discussion for the city of Lewes. The social scene was one of private clubs, music, and billiards. Streets were unpaved and local physicians visited patients by horse and buggy, or attended to them in their offices. It was not uncommon for an emergency surgery to be carried out in a patient's home.

Local physicians James Beebe, Sr., M.D., and Richard C. Beebe, M.D., the sons of longtime Lewes residents Richard and Temperance Jane Magee Beebe, saw the need for a hospital in the small community that, even then, swelled with summer tourists visiting nearby Rehoboth Beach. Both physicians had earned their medical degrees in Philadelphia from Jefferson College, and they already had an office in town.

In 1916, they founded the first private, community hospital in Sussex County. It was an addition built onto

their office. It included two patient rooms, three beds, and an operating room. It became known as Beebe Hospital.

By the next year, Dr. James Beebe, Sr., became the president of the Medical Society of Delaware, cementing the tiny hospital's connection to the state's professional medical leadership.

“The community of Lewes has really benefited by having the hospital here,” says Lewes native and published local historian Hazel Brittingham. “The knowledge and interest of the Beebe brothers remains here today.”

This year, Beebe Medical Center officially celebrates its 90th anniversary. It is a community-owned, not-for-profit hospital. It has grown to a 148-bed facility that offers progressive and comprehensive care in cancer treatment, orthopaedic surgery, women's health, and emergency medicine, to name just a few.

The medical staff has grown in the last few years to more than 200 physicians, who bring more than 30 specialties to the area. A new Beebe Health Campus, opened in 2003 on Route 24 in the Rehoboth Beach area, offers numerous outpatient services including diagnostic imaging, lab services, physical therapy, and surgery. The Tunnell Cancer Center, currently in Lewes, is moving to the Route 24 location into a larger and more modern facility. Satellite facilities dot eastern Sussex County, and a new Open Heart Surgery and Interventional Cardiology Program will start later this year. Beebe Medical Center will offer this new, cardiac

surgery program through a unique affiliation with Christiana Care Health System, a teaching hospital recognized for its excellence in cardiovascular programs. The Center for Heart & Vascular Health at Christiana Hospital is one of the mid-Atlantic's largest, most experienced cardiovascular programs. Its nationally renowned cardiovascular surgery team performed Delaware's first open-heart surgery in 1986. Today, its team performs almost 800 open-heart procedures a year. As part of the affiliation, a Christiana Care cardiac surgeon will be based at Beebe Medical Center and will be supported by a team of Christiana Care cardiac

In 1958, 1,016 surgical operations were carried out at Beebe, a 400 percent increase over the 275 operations performed in 1938. Since then, our technology and capabilities have continued to grow, and by 2006 our surgical procedures increased to 6,734.

“Monitoring systems, MRI and CT scans, computers, and radiation equipment for cancer treatment are common technologies here today. IBEX, the computerized charting system in the Emergency Department, compiles information on every patient and helps me correctly place patients being admitted so they receive the level of care they need.

“There were six physicians when I started. Today, there are more than 200. Patient care has become more complex and nurses need knowledge in anatomy, physiology, pharmacology, psychology, computers, and new technologies. Case managers, patient advocates, and the hospital chaplain are essential members of our healthcare team.”

surgeons. The team at Christiana Care's Center for Heart & Vascular Health also has worked closely with Beebe Medical Center in the training of the staff members who will care for the cardiac surgery patients. Today, Beebe, about 1,600 employees strong, still focuses on meeting the needs of its community.

“The communities that we serve are growing at an

astounding rate, and we want to be ready to serve them,” Jeffrey M. Fried, FACHE, Beebe Medical Center President and CEO, told those attending the groundbreaking of the \$35 million expansion now under way. “This expansion, as well as

the other projects now taking place, will allow us to continue to bring needed services and facilities to our communities.”

Dr. James Beebe, Jr., son of founder Dr. James Beebe, Sr., says he is proud of what the medical center has accomplished. “There has been so much change that it is difficult to point to what has been the most significant,” he says. “But I think that what has been most outstanding is that Beebe has kept up with the times and has stayed ahead of the curve.”

The Honorable Eugene Bookhammer, Chairman of the Beebe Medical Foundation and a Sussex County entrepreneur and former Delaware Lt. Governor who

has been an active supporter of Beebe for more than 50 years, says the biggest changes in the technologies and services Beebe offers the community have been seen over the last 20 years.

“The recent growth has been unbelievable,” he says. “The population growth is driving the growth of the hospital.”

Mr. Bookhammer, who has worked hard over the decades to raise money for Beebe, recalls that there were years, especially in the early 1970s, when the area was not growing, and neither was Beebe.

“For two years we had to borrow money to make payroll,” he recalls, noting that things were not easy and that it took commitment from many to keep the hospital afloat.

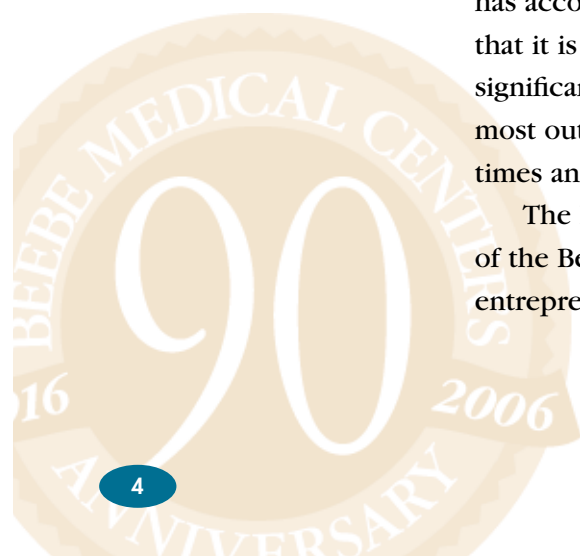

“I was the first orthopaedic surgeon here and served alone for five years,” he recalls. “Now look at what we have. Just about every specialty is represented.”

Dr. Marvel, who serves as Trauma Director, says that he is particularly proud of Beebe’s involvement in the statewide trauma systems program that was developed about a decade ago. Medical centers with emergency departments and independent emergency organizations work together to get immediate medical care for trauma patients. “This system definitely saves lives, and our staff is an important part of that.”

Beebe Medical Center’s ties to statewide medical leadership have continued throughout its existence. Dr. James Beebe, Jr., for example, was a founding member of the Delaware Chapter of the American College of Surgeons.

Dr. Marvel twice served as President of the Medical Society of Delaware, from 1991 to 1992 and from 2004 to 2005.

Beebe Medical Center has had relationships with Christiana Care Healthcare Systems in Wilmington, the most outstanding being their affiliation to create a joint heart program.

Many agree that it was the initial commitment by the Beebe brothers that allowed the medical center to expand so dramatically and in such a sophisticated manner to meet the needs of coastal Delaware’s present burgeoning population.

“A lot of small hospitals started up and failed,”

Marvel says, explaining that it was the co-founder, Dr. James Beebe, Sr., who worked diligently to keep the money and the support from the medical community flowing at critical times during the early years.

Dr. James Beebe, Sr., who not only had earned his medical degree at Jefferson College, but a business degree in Wilmington as well, had important connections. Both brothers had the commitment and the work ethic it took to sustain a young hospital.

Funding for the early expansions of the hospital came from Wilmington residents Benjamin F and Helen M. Shaw, and later Mary Thompson. These donors were summer visitors to Rehoboth and wanted to support the doctors in their efforts to bring modern medicine to the community. The Shaws funded two major additions, which by 1927 brought the hospital to a 60-bed capacity. Mary Thompson, who had been treated at Beebe in 1934, raised \$100,000 for the hospital, which funded the construction of the Thompson wing.

The hospital rooms in the Lynch Wing were considered some of the most modern facilities, leading the hospital into the 1970s. Currently, Beebe has 148 licensed beds.

Furnished with only one delivery chair, a total of 80 newborns were delivered in 1938. As the number of Beebe-delivered babies increased, so did the need for quality maternity care. Currently, Beebe now delivers approximately 985 babies each year.

The Beebe brothers also realized the need for a School of Nursing, establishing that school in 1921. During its first nine months it was affiliated with Delaware Hospital in Wilmington. Since then, the school has maintained independent status. The school itself was built in 1960, thanks to funding by DuPont family member Jean Ellen DuPont Shehan.

Dr. Marvel recalls that at the onset of the hospital, Dr. James Beebe, Sr., knew that if he couldn't provide the medical care here, he knew who could. He gained the support of a number of Philadelphia-area specialists who regularly visited Beebe Medical Center and its patients.

Dr. James Beebe, Jr., who had joined his father and uncle in 1950 as the hospital's first formally trained surgeon, recalls the many specialists who visited his family when he was growing up.

Nina Beebe Hazzard, MS, BSN, R.N., Dr. James Beebe, Jr.'s daughter and the current Curriculum Coordinator for the Beebe School of Nursing, has the same memories from when she was a child. "Specialists came regularly in the '60s and '70s," she recalls. "We did a good job of bringing quality physicians here."

This was a tradition for the small, community hospital at a time when the population would not sustain a large number of specialists.

Mrs. Hazzard left Lewes to earn her degree in nursing at the University of Delaware, working as a tech at Beebe each summer. After earning her degree, she worked as a nurse in Wilmington and Philadelphia

before returning to Beebe in 1978. "Our gift then was that our doctors were good diagnosticians. We sent our patients to larger hospitals."

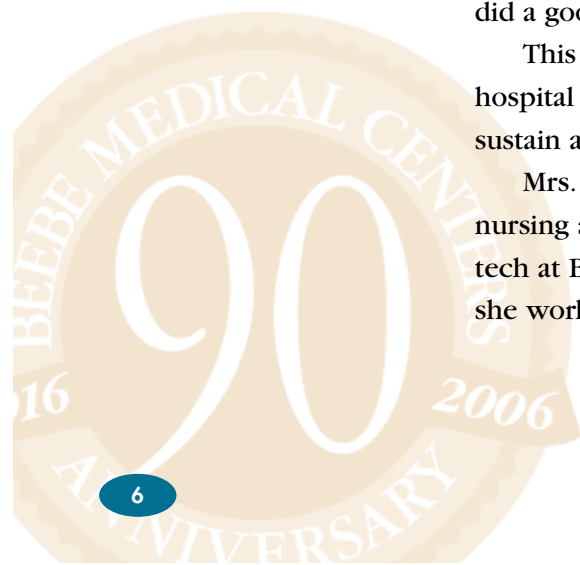
While Mrs. Hazzard's father strived to bring top physicians to the community, friends and associates supported his medical efforts by raising the money needed to expand the hospital itself. The Honorable Eugene Bookhammer, who attended Lewes School with Dr. James Beebe, Jr., and later started his own lumber company, has been a key player in fundraising.

"You have to put back into the community, and a lot of people have felt that way," says Mr. Bookhammer.

The late Harry W. Lynch, Sr., a Wilmington resident with a home in Rehoboth Beach, also was a friend, and a force in the effort to raise money. The five-story Lynch building, which opened in 1970, was named after him. It was the first major expansion in 25 years and, at the time, was considered by hospital authorities to be one of the most modern hospital facilities on the East Coast. The building included radiology,

laboratories, and a maternity department.

Mrs. Hazzard says the biggest change that came about in her lifetime was the addition of the five-story Rollins Wing in 1985, which resulted in a modern critical care unit, state-of-the-art monitoring systems and diagnostic technologies, and other advancements. The building was named after Beebe supporter and Delaware business magnate the late John W. Rollins, who started his first Delaware business in Lewes.

In 1995, the Hastings HeartCare Program was established and funded through the generosity of Edward C. and Joanne Hastings. Then thanks to the support of the late Robert Tunnell and his widow, Eolyne Tunnell, Beebe opened a much-needed cancer center. At the same time, the hospital opened the Baylis Rehabilitation Center through a generous gift from the late Norman and Helen (Puggy) Baylis. Beebe Medical Center recognized the many contributions made by Norman B. Baylis, John W. Rollin, Sr., and Robert W. Tunnell, Sr., and their years of service on the Board, by establishing in 2002 the Beebe Honors program. The Tunnell Cancer Center has moved to the Beebe Health Campus, and the physical therapy center there has been rededicated as the Baylis Rehabilitation Center.

Although the medical center has grown exponentially over the decades, it has maintained a stable and nurturing family environment. Not only have Beebe family members worked within its walls, but children and other relatives of employees also work there. Many have stayed for decades.

“Beebe has been a very good place to work,” says JoAnn Lathbury, R.N., who was a nurse for Beebe for 30 years before moving into the Information Systems Department as a systems analyst.

“I could retire now, but I don’t want to,” she says. “It’s family here. Even though Lewes has grown so much, it still has that certain, small-town spirit.” Ms. Lathbury is somewhat nostalgic about how it used to be when the hospital was smaller, and when Lewes was smaller. Everyone knew each other, and there was a time when employees ate for free in the cafeteria.

But, on the other hand, she’s very happy to see the advances in medicine that have occurred during the past 10 to 15 years.

“I used to joke and say that before I retire they’ll have open-heart surgery. It looks like it’s really going to happen.”

Ms. Lathbury likes her work in the Information Systems Department because she gets to meet so many employees throughout the hospital, and because she is learning about what is going on. “I can tell you that this is the only place I want to come when I need care.” ■

Through the years, the community benefited not only from Beebe’s advanced technology, but also in an area in which no dollar value can be placed—patient care. The hospital’s location always allowed neighbors to care for neighbors and close relationships to form between staff and clients.

KEEPING ATHLETES IN SHAPE

KEEPING ALL OF US ACTIVE AS WE AGE

John Farro considered himself in pretty good shape. Although at age 38 he wasn't the athlete he used to be in school when he played football and basketball, he was still an active person. After all, he had served in the Marines and had done triathlons. That's why he thought nothing of playing in his company's annual flag football "Turkey Bowl" game last Thanksgiving.

"I caught a pass and I was running downfield," he recalls. "I cut back to go another direction. Suddenly, I heard a tear and a pop in my knee. I went down." By the next day he could hardly walk and his knee

kept buckling. Mr. Farro soon had surgery for the reconstruction of the anterior cruciate ligament (ACL)—the primary restraint to the forward movement of the knee.

Mr. Farro went through months of physical therapy and rehabilitation. It was hard work, he recalls, but he lost 15 pounds and got himself back in shape. Now he works out every day, making sure he can keep up with his three young children.

"It was a blessing in disguise, a wake-up call," he says of the injury. "It got me to remember how important it is to stay in shape, and to make sure the body is warmed up before I take part in any kind of sport or exercise program."

Mr. Farro’s message—preventive measures to make the body strong and flexible are important to avoid injuries—is echoed by physicians, orthopaedic surgeons, and others in the medical community who care for people who have been injured while taking part in competitive sports, or in weekend activities such as golf, tennis, and fundraising runs and walks. If an injury occurs, even something as seemingly minor as a pain in the foot or an ache in the shoulder, it should be attended to by a medical professional.

“The last thing people want to do is to stop exercising when they are in pain,” says Jeffrey Hawtof, M.D., member of the Beebe medical staff, and Medical Director of Cape Henlopen High School Wellness Center. “Our goal in treating is to keep them as active as long as we can.”

It is a well-known fact that exercise helps prevent heart disease, diabetes, and other illnesses, especially as people age.

Mr. Farro’s surgery was performed by Mark J. Boytim, M.D., a Beebe orthopaedic surgeon who is fellowship trained in sports medicine.

Referring to the kind of injury that Mr. Farro suffered, Dr. Boytim says, “This twisting injury to the knee, often referred to as ‘blowing out the knee’, is common in football and usually needs to be treated surgically in younger patients.” Most sports injuries do not require surgery, he explains, but if the injury is diagnosed and treated early, there is a better chance

for the patient to recover and continue doing the activities he or she enjoys.

Dr. Boytim warns, though, that to ignore an injury could lead to the necessity for more serious surgeries in the future.

William J. Barrish, M.D., a physiatrist with Orthopaedic Associates of Southern Delaware and a member of the Beebe Medical Center medical staff, knows that people often are afraid to go to a physician because they fear they will have to undergo surgery. “Yet only about 20 percent of those who visit a physician for a sports-related injury need surgery,” he says. “The majority can be treated non-surgically.”

Tennis elbow, golf elbow, some rotator cuff injuries, Achilles tendonitis, shin pain, and other pain and inflammation are the types of injuries that can be treated successfully without surgery.

“The most important thing is to get over an acute episode and then use physical therapy, ultrasound, and some other means to build up the strength of the muscle and let it heal on its own,” says Dr. Barrish.

Common therapies that help with the healing process include mild electrical currents (electrostimulation), cold packs (cryotherapy), heat packs (thermotherapy), sound waves (ultrasound), and massage, according to the National Institutes of Health.

Dr. Barrish says there are even non-surgical therapies to help people with arthritis stay active.

Todd Fuhrmann, ATC, NASM-PES, athletic trainer at Indian River High School, strongly advocates training to avoid injuries. He works with student athletes through Beebe Medical Center’s Wellness Center on the school campus.

“We focus on fitness, offering full-strength conditioning to promote speed, endurance, balance, agility, strength, and power,” he says. “Being out of shape increases chance for injury. But, injuries can and do happen anyway.”

Mr. Fuhrmann says that he immediately begins care for any student athlete who has suffered an injury by using the “RICE” method—Rest, Ice, Compression, and Elevation.

“If it is past our scope, such as if a fracture is suspected, we refer the student to an orthopaedic surgeon. Or, if the pain doesn’t go away in three or four days, we send the student to the doctor.”

Such was the case with Indian River High School graduate Shauna Jacobs. Shauna, who plays softball and volleyball, had suffered a shoulder injury in middle school—before she was in Indian River’s structured training program. As time went by, her shoulder kept getting dislocated.

The damage was not evident on an MRI, Shauna recalls, pointing out that she had been seen by several doctors before she found Paul J. Harriott, M.D., an orthopaedic surgeon on the Beebe medical staff who is fellowship trained in sports medicine. After examining Shauna, Dr. Harriott decided that he needed to surgically tighten her shoulder.

“I was in the 10th grade,” Shauna recalls. “The week before my surgery my shoulder dislocated five times. It was horrible.”

Dr. Harriott says that her shoulder had become seriously unstable because the “capsule” around the joint, formed by ligaments, had been stretched to the point that the muscles could no longer compensate. Surgically, he tightened the capsule by making a pleat in the ligament through tiny arthroscopic incisions. Following the surgery, Shauna sat out her junior year

fall volleyball season to work with physical therapy and her trainer. She regained strength in her arm and played in the spring softball season and continued to play sports in her senior year.

Today, Shauna is a freshman at Wesley College in Dover and will be playing on the college's volleyball and softball teams.

"It's like I'm as good as new," she says about the surgery. Now, she follows the direction of her trainer, making sure that she is stretching and strengthening her muscles.

While most people don't have access to these certified athletic trainers, they can still take preventive measures to keep in shape, the experts say. Like John Farro, they can develop an exercise program with the help of a physical therapist or a personal trainer.

According to Mark Blaskey, Director of Rehabilitation Services at Beebe Medical Center, they can practice Tai Chi, a martial art known for its therapeutic effects on the body. Mr. Blaskey teaches a regular Tai Chi class at Beebe Medical Center through the Integrative Health Department.

Dr. Barrish agrees that Tai Chi is an excellent way to keep the body in shape, especially for the older population who may not be able to do other, more strenuous, exercises. He also suggested yoga.

"Stretching is the key," Dr. Barrish says.

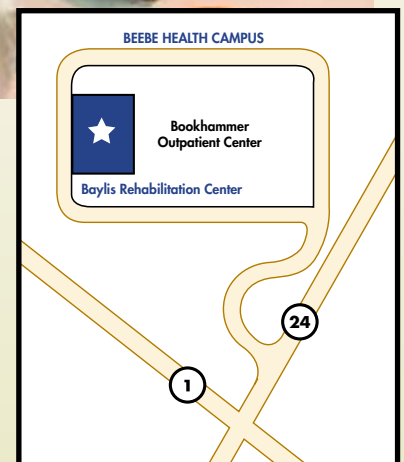

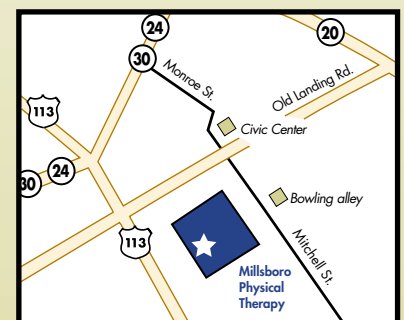

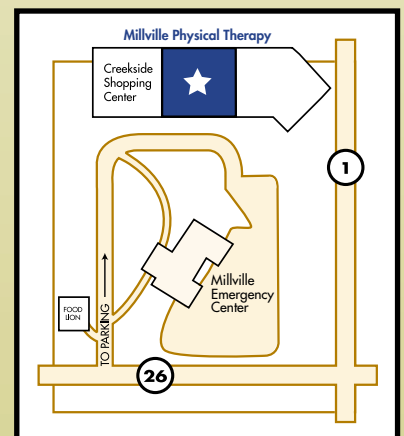
